**Local rules**

- Out of bounds (Rule 18.2)
  - a) Beyond the course side margin of any wall, fence or tarmac road bounding the course
  - b) Beyond any line of white stakes
  - c) Over the river on 7th fairway
- Abnormal course conditions (Rule 16.1)
  - a) Areas marked as GUR or enclosed with white lines.
  - b) Seeded ground in closely mown areas.
  - c) Deep ruts made by vehicle tyres
- Protection of young trees
 

If a tree is under 2 club lengths in height and interferes with a player's stance or swing the player must take relief (Rule 16.1b)
- Immovable obstructions (Rule 16.1)
  - a) A ball striking an overhead power line must be replayed without penalty.
  - b) Any pole supporting an overhead power line is an immovable obstruction and a ball hitting an immovable obstruction must be played as it lies.
- Equipment (Rule 4.3a)
 

Distance measuring devices are permitted for the purpose of assessing distance only.
- Any temporary Local Rules as defined on the notice board.

**Penalty for Breach of Local Rules**
