

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS RULE(27)

- A. Beyond any wall, fence or tarmac road bounding course
- B. Beyond any line of white stakes

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25)

- A. Areas marked as GUR or enclosed with white lines
- B. Seeded ground (not divot marks) in closely mown areas
- C. Deep ruts made by vehicle tyres

PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

If a tree is under 2 club length in height interferes with a players stance or area of intended swing the player **MUST** take relief under (RULE 24-2B)

STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions

OVERHEAD POWER LINES

If a ball strikes an overhead power line the player **MUST**

disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball as near as possible to the spot from which the original ball was played without penalty (RULE 20-5)

Any pole supporting an overhead power line is an immovable obstruction and a ball hitting a pole should be played as it lies (RULE 19-1) or if the pole interferes with a players stroke or area of intended swing then relief shall be gained under (RULE 24-2)

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE (RULE 14-3)

A player may obtain distance information by a device that measures distance only

Any local temporary rule as defined on notice board

PENALTY for LOCAL RULE breach STROKE PLAY=TWO strokes

PENALTY for LOCAL RULE breach MATCH PLAY=ONE HOLE
